vanessa freerks analyzes how baudrillard re actualizes nietzsche s on the genealogy of morals investigating how themes and approaches in baudrillard s consumer society simulacra and simulations and symbolic exchange and death resonate with nietzsche s on the genealogy of morals this book fills a gap in the limited literature available on the relation between

in his new book perhaps the most cogent expression of his mature thought jean baudrillard turns detective in order to investigate a crime which he hopes may yet be solved the murder of reality to solve the crime would be to unravel the social and technological processes by which reality has quite simply vanished under the deadly glare of media real time but baudrillard is not merely intending to lament the disappearance of the real an occurrence he recently described as the most important event of modern history nor even to meditate upon the
